AIDS United-Grantee

- **AIDS United serves as the Grantee overseeing the programming of the Melanated Movement Fund**
- **AIDS United is responsible for the following:**
 - **Overseeing the Pre-Application and Full Application Process**
 - **Providing Technical Assistance**
 - **Grants Management**
 - **Melanated Movement Fund Convenings**

Purpose

Address the structural and social barriers faced by Black women impacted by HIV by supporting holistic, tailored, and innovative approaches to HIV prevention and care.

Grantees will be funded and supported to implement and/or expand a tailored program to engage Black women in HIV prevention and/or care services in one or more areas:

- **Arts & Advocacy**
- **Community**
- **Education**
- **Addressing social determinants of health**

Gilead Setting the P.A.C.E Initiative

The mission of the Gilead Setting the P.A.C.E. initiative is to increase HIV prevention, health equity, and anti-stigma efforts for cisgender and Transgender Black women and girls in the United States by supporting projects that aim to improve the HIV landscape through innovative approaches

PRE-APPLICATION PROCESS

Eligibility

- **Nonprofit Status**

Applicants must be nonprofit, tax-exempt organizations, per the guidelines set forth by the Internal Revenue Service, with proper 501(c)(3) status

- **Geographical Location**

Applicants must be located and perform work within the United States

Eligibility cont.

- **Financial Stability**

Organizations should have the financial ability to operate for the duration of the grant period.

- **Equity**

Prioritization of funding will be for organizations led by and serving Black cisgender and transgender women, as well as organizations in high-needs jurisdictions like the U.S. South.

Eligibility cont.

- **Grant Period**

Applicants must be able to utilize the funds within the 27-month grant period (July 1, 2024 – September 30, 2026).

Requirements

● Participation in Evaluation

Grantees will be asked to report the number of unduplicated beneficiaries, the demographics of beneficiaries (age, race/ethnicity, gender identity, HIV status, and sexual orientation) of each beneficiary, and service utilization data.

Organizations will be provided technical assistance to collect the requested qualitative and quantitative data and information as needed.

Requirements cont.

● Participation in Technical Assistance

Grantees will be required to:

- Attend a grantee convening in the fall of 2024
- Participate in virtual technical assistance calls quarterly

Written pre-application

A pre-recorded video

● Deadline

Pre-application deadline is April 4,

2024, 11:59 PM EST

● Submission Requirement

A pre-application is the first stage in our selection process.

Submitting a pre-application is required for full application
